2025 TRIENNIAL SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

The proposed common election date is Wednesday 10th September. The Board will confirm what date we will use at the next board meeting.

- Even although it seems to be still some way off It won't take long for the date to be right in front of your all.
- The election cycle is later in the year due to the being pushed out in the 2022 election cycle.
- Sue Hewitt has been appointed as the Returning Officer for these elections.
- The 3 Yearly Elections mean that all 5 Elected Parent Representative Positions are re-elected. Some of the current members are stepping down and some are standing again so there will be positions to fill.
- The Staff Representative is also re-elected at this time even though Paula von Dadelszen was appointed through a by-election at the start of the year
- 5 Elected Parent Representatives is our board's allocation under our Constitution but any board can co-opt or select other people
 on to the board at their discretion for a variety of reasons as long as the number of them does not exceed the number of elected
 members
- Ben Percival was co-opted on in October last year for 3 years so he remains on the board and his position is not part of the upcoming election process.
- You don't have to be a parent to be nominated to go on a school board BUT ONLY Parents or Legal Guardians can vote in the
 elections.
- Please think seriously about offering your services for the good of the school and your children.
